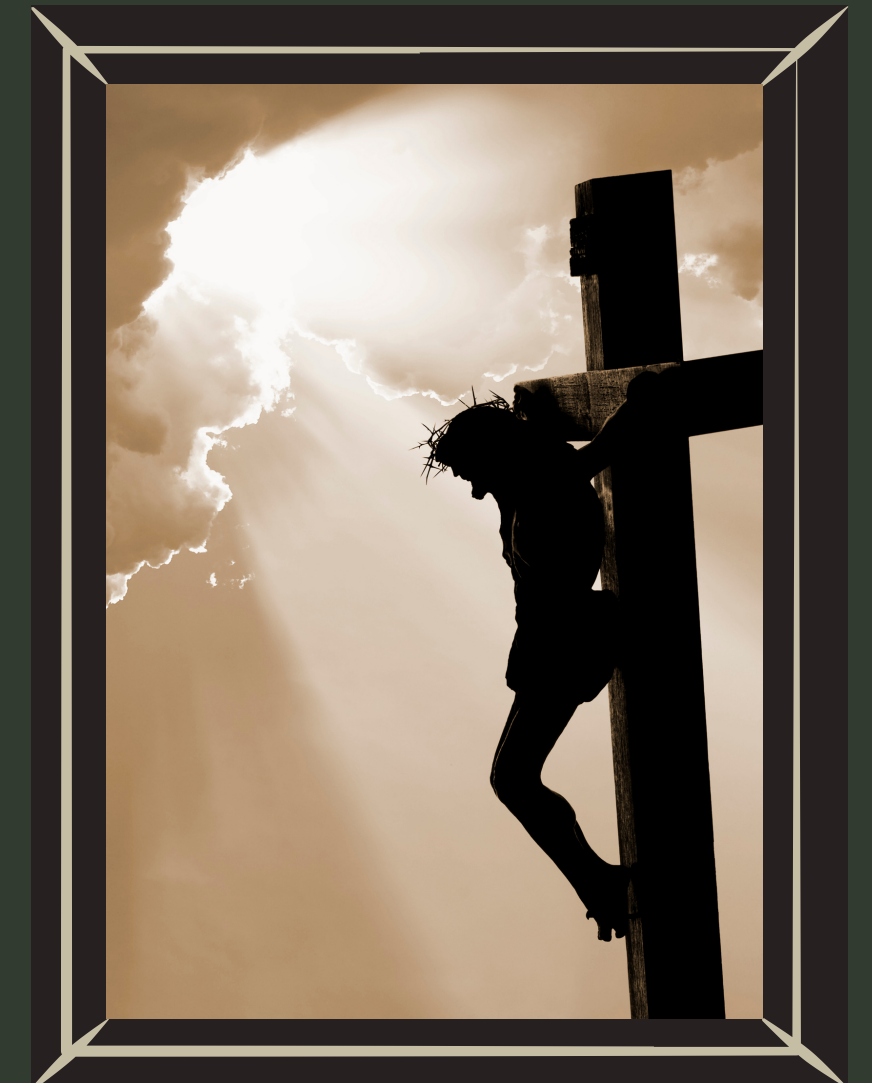

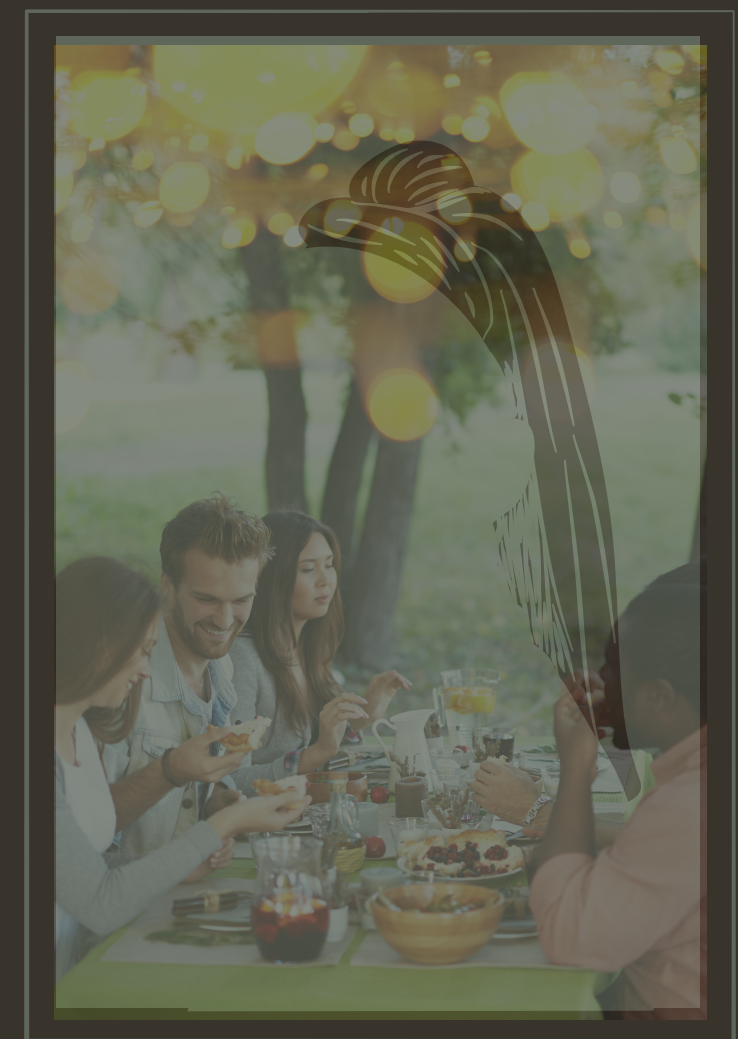

Psalm 1:1 Oh, the joys of those who.

The first word of the psalm, 'ashre (traditionally translated “**blessed**”), is a key word that runs through the Psalter from beginning to end. No single English word captures the full sense of 'ashre. Those who are 'ashre are in a state of total well-being: They lack nothing (34:8-10 [9-11]), are delivered from trouble (41:1-2 [2-3]; 94:12-13), and are wealthy and have successful children (112:1-3; 128:1-4; 144:12-15).

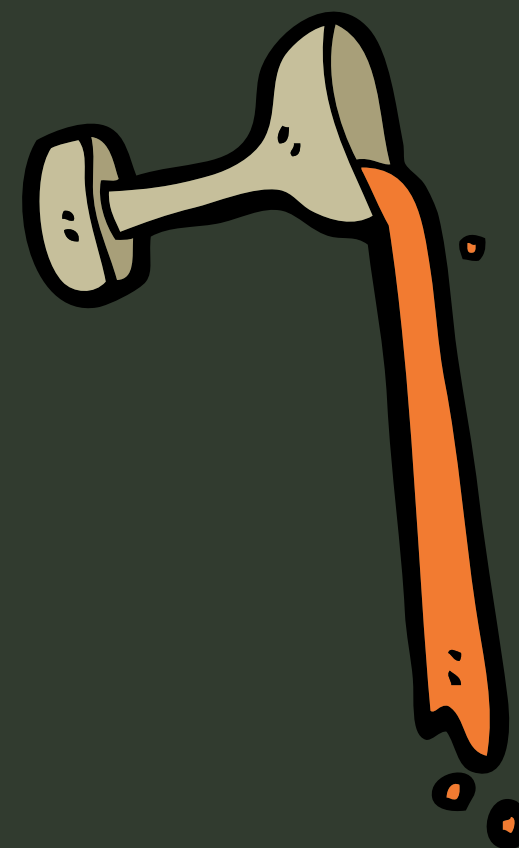

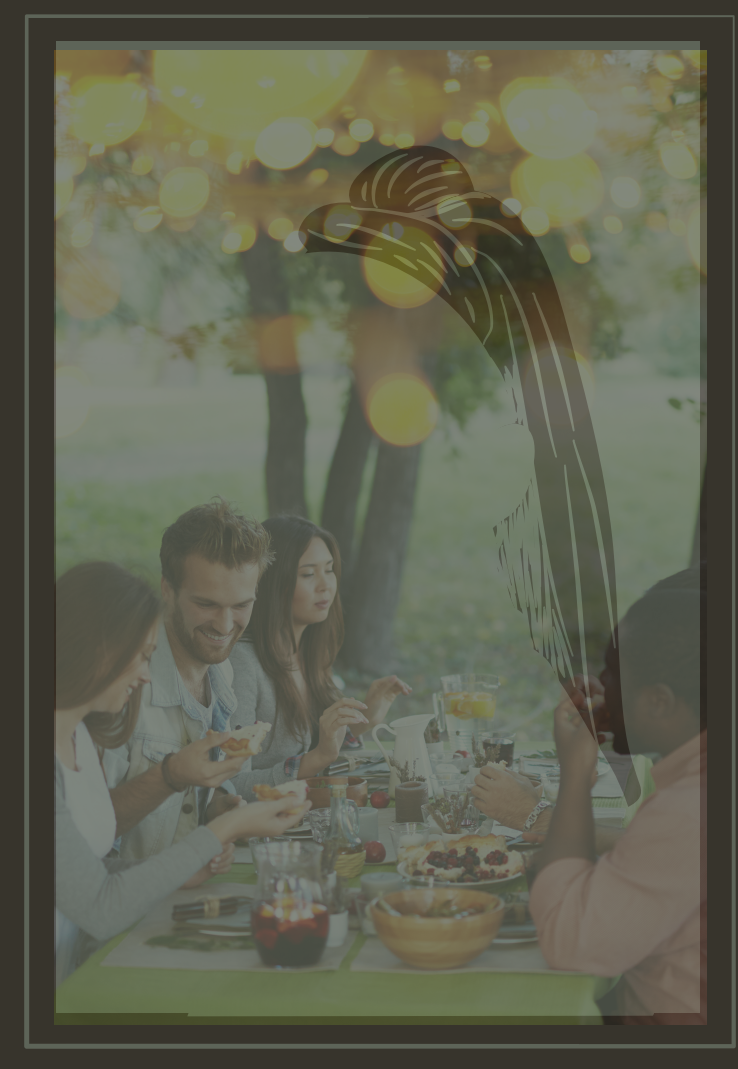
