

Day 2 Craft Paul's Boat



<u>Bible Point:</u> Jesus' power gives us hope.

Bible Verse: "So be strong and courageous, all you who put your hope in the Lord."

Psalm 31:24

<u>Bible Story:</u> Paul encourages others in a storm and shipwreck. (Acts 27)

Day 2: Paul's Shipwreck Boat

Materials: sponge (or a slice of a pool noodle), material for sails (craft foam, fabric, leaves, paper plate- anything that can withstand a little water), something to hold sail (craft stick, stick from yard, straw, pencil etc).

- 1. Have your child create one or two sails out of whatever material you can provide
- 2. Help your child punch two holes into each sail, one towards the top of the sail and one towards the bottom
- 3. Attach sails to whatever you have to hold them
- 4. Attach to sponge

You may need to experiment a little to figure out what will help the boat to float. If you can't get your boat to float don't panic! Use this to talk about Paul getting

shipwrecked and how that might have been very scary. Ask them what gave Paul hope in this situation.

Try using your boat at bath time and see if your child can retell the Bible lesson from today.

As an alternative/with older kids, have kids create their own boat out of whatever they can find outside and see if it will float!
