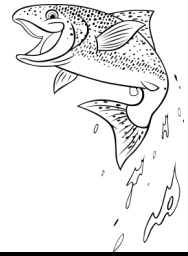


Day 4 Craft

Cross



Bible Point: Jesus' power lets us live forever.

Bible Verse: "The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you."
Romans 8:11

Bible Story: Jesus' death and resurrection. (Matthew 26:17-28:10)

Day 4: Cross

Materials: black construction paper, brown construction paper, several colorful pieces of construction paper (you can paint or color on a white sheet of paper if you don't have construction paper at home); white paper/posterboard/canvas; scissors, and glue

1. Cut out a cross shape from the black paper.
2. Cut out a hill shape from the brown paper.
3. Tear a strip from each colored sheet about 2-3 inches wide.
(these don't need to be the same size, nor do they need to be straight. The jagged tear makes your background look even better).
4. Choose what order you want your colored strips to go in. Begin at the bottom of your white cardstock/posterboard/canvas. Glue strips on, one at a time, slightly layering each strip.
5. Glue your hill at the bottom.
6. Glue your cross on top of the hill.



Find a place in your home/child's room to display your child's art.

Ask them how the cross reminds them of how Jesus's power lets us live forever. Have them tell you how Jesus was different than anyone else who has ever lived.
