WORSHIP SERVICE THIS SUNDAY, OCTOBER 18: Two separate worship services will be offered online and onsite at the church at 9:00 am (Classic in the Sanctuary) and 11:00 am (Convergent in King Hall). Dr. Jonathan Schwartz will be preaching both services this week, using Luke 20:20-26 as his text.

MOVING FORWARD IN FAITH & WISDOM: GUIDELINES FOR GATHERING – You will notice that we have updated our Guidelines to include the Safe Screening questions. You will see new signage around our campus to help remind us all of the things that we can do to maintain a safe space for gathering. You may also find these Guidelines on the home page of our website.

These guidelines apply to any activity that we have on our church campus and to those FPC-sponsored events that take place off site. In short, we are practicing social distancing, hand sanitizing, and the wearing of face coverings when we cannot consistently maintain social distance of 6 feet. We are being very strategic about seating in our worship services and in our Wednesday Night Family Gathering.

There is much conflicting information out there about quarantine, isolation, what an exposure is, and so forth. Our church leaders have chosen to follow CDC guidelines regarding exposures and for those who are COVID positive. If you have a question as to whether or not you or your family member should attend an event on our campus, please reach out to our church office. We are happy to help answer your questions.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD 2020 - The goals of Operation Christmas Child are **evangelism, discipleship and church planting**. *At an OCC outreach event in a very remote Liberian village, 70 people responded to the Gospel and accepted Christ as their Lord and Savior. Just one week later, a Liberian pastor, returned to the village to lead the first worship service, and, thus, a new church was born in this previously unreached region of Liberia.*

Each box is a GIFT to a child to show the love of Jesus. Each child has the opportunity to take a twelve-week Bible class and is given a New Testament in his language at the completion of the course. New believers, children, and adults are plugged into local churches.

Your shoebox gift offers an opportunity to serve others as a missionary in a time of limited contact and travel. Your shoebox gift presents children, parents, and neighbors with the gospel. Your shoebox gift helps international church pastors to disciple and build churches. Your shoebox gift teaches our FPC children about giving and serving others in a tangible way.
